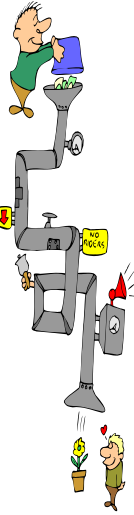



Recycling

Your Assistance is **ESSENTIAL** to save the **ENVIRONMENT** and the life of the landfill.

Cardboard recycling has added an estimated six years to the life of the Baggs Road Landfill Site. The Site Liaison Committee thanks everyone for their cooperation and requests that you continue to **REDUCE, REUSE AND RECYCLE**. Also, bring all of your unwanted **Electronics** to the Site for recycling.



 Use the Blue Box for all recyclables. Do not put recyclable material in with regular garbage.

Baggs Road has a composting area for all of your yard waste. Bring in your grass clippings, garden waste, leaves and chipped wood/brush.

Tips for Reducing Waste

- ◇ Take unwanted toys and books to hospitals, community centers or schools
- ◇ Give unwanted clothing to charities or put them in drop bins
- ◇ Use empty plastic packaging containers for freezing or storing food items
- ◇ Buy in bulk to reduce packaging
- ◇ Take a shopping bag with you so that you don't have to use a plastic one from the store and add extra waste in the landfill
- ◇ Donate unwanted computer equipment and TVs to friends, Family Services or have them recycled by the Baggs Road Site.
- ◇ Reuse wrapping paper and gift boxes.

**Miller Road Waste Site
Construction and Demolition Waste
Must go to the Miller Road Site**

Construction and Demolition waste is defined as all non-hazardous low metal content waste from construction and demolition projects, consisting primarily of wood, blocks/stone/bricks, non-metal roofing material, insulation, window glass, non metal siding material, concrete, small amounts of plastic and fiberglass and wooden furniture. Baggs Road accepts household garbage, scrap metal, brush and yard waste, compost material, tires, waste electronics, most HHW including car batteries, paint, and PCB-free oil, upholstered furniture, mattresses, box springs and cushions.

There is also an area for “reuse” items. These are items that you no longer want but are in good condition and may be of use to someone else.



Tires

Residents are entitled to dispose of tires free of charge either on or off rims.

And the good news is that when you bring tires, electronics and household hazardous wastes to the Baggs Road Site the Site is paid for collecting these materials which helps lower our taxes.

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)

Practice the 3H's

HALT Limit the use of hazardous products and only buy what you need.

HEED all warning labels and instructions for use, handling and disposal of all hazardous products

HANDLE all hazardous materials with care

Hazardous Waste Accepted (Baggs Rd)

The following HHW can be accepted free of charge at the Baggs Rd. Site:

Motor oil, paint, stain, automotive batteries, compressed gas cylinders (e.g. propane, butane), refrigerant-containing appliances (e.g. refrigerators, dehumidifiers), gasoline, diesel fuel, solvents, antifreeze, heating oil, rechargeable dry cell batteries, single use batteries, fertilizers, pesticides, herbicides antifreeze, acids, alkaline wastes, organic/inorganic chemicals, fluorescent lights and light fuels (gas, diesel, camp fuel etc.).

Did you know

- ◇ Dry empty paint cans can be recycled
- ◇ Hazardous waste when disposed of in landfills contaminates groundwater
- ◇ Household hazardous waste poured down drains kills microbes used in sewage treatment plants and septic systems and pollutes our water
- ◇ Burning hazardous waste causes air pollution
- ◇ Paint, when available at the Baggs Road Site HHW Area is free of charge for residents
